Crocus Obedience & Kennel Club (COKC) permits Junior Handlers (defined as a handler under the age of 16), under the following conditions:

- The Junior must be physically able to handle dog, and the dog must be of suitable temperament to be handled by a Junior. The COKC instructor has the right to refuse the Junior entry into class if the instructor determines that the dog is not of suitable size or temperament for the Junior.
- The Junior must be accompanied by a parent or guardian, and this individual must remain throughout the duration of the classes.
- Both the Junior and the parent or guardian must sign registration form waiver.
- If a problem arises, the COKC instructor will provide the following options: permit the parent or guardian to take over from the Junior; or allow the Junior to drop out of the class and receive a prorated refund.
